

**PUBLIC NOTICE FOR
REAPPOINTMENT OF INCUMBENT BANKRUPTCY JUDGE**

The current 14-year term of office of Robert D. Berger, United States Bankruptcy Judge for the District of Kansas at Kansas City, Kansas, is due to expire on October 15, 2017. The United States Court of Appeals for the Tenth Circuit is presently considering whether to reappoint Judge Berger to a new 14-year term of office.

Upon reappointment, Judge Berger would continue to exercise the jurisdiction of a bankruptcy judge, as specified in Titles 11 and 28 of the United States Code.
